Celtic Festival & Community Dog Show - July 18 - 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.

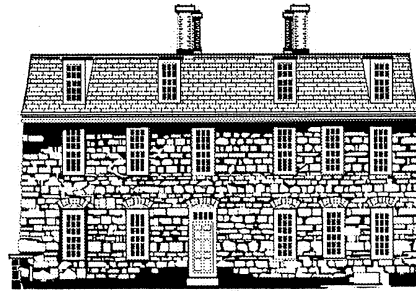

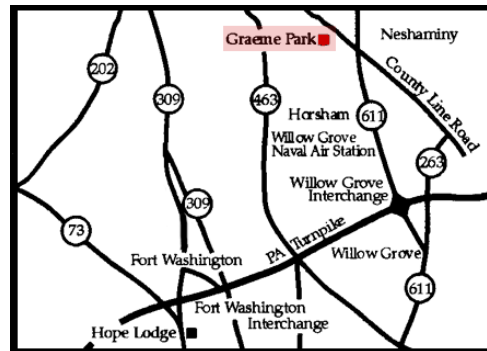

- No refunds will be made after April 1, 2009.

Other Things to Know

- Campers should bring a cold lunch with their name on it. Lunches will be stored in the refrigerator.
- Campers should wear comfortable clothing that it is OK to get dirty and closed-toe shoes.
- Most activities are outside, so we advise children to use sunscreen and insect repellent daily.
- Children should bring a shoebox with a lid and a large shopping bag to keep their crafts in.
- Campers should bring a smock for messy crafts.
- Drop off is between 9:45 and 10:00 a.m. daily at the Visitor's Center.
- Pick up is at 2:30 each day at the Visitor's Center.
